I Objectives

Jincheon 1st World Youth Martial Arts Masterships will be held in Jincheon County, Chungcheongbuk-do Province, Republic of Korea from 3 to 7 November 2017. The very first edition of this event is under the theme “Harmony of the World Martial Arts” which is expecting continuous growth to the best martial arts competitions around the world traditional martial arts which will be following Masterships movement.

II Masterships Overview

III AGE AND WEIGHT CATEGORIES

I Eligible Age:

- 1997 - 2001(original passport will be required at draw)

2 Weight Category:

- Male - 60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, and +90 kg
- Female - 52kg, -63kg, -70kg and +70kg

Each nation can enter maximum two(2) players in each weight category.

Each nation can enter one referee who has international 2 or 3 star.

3.1 Eligibility

The martial artist who is commensurate with rules of IKA is eligible to participate in the Jincheon World Youth Martial Arts Masterships.

The participating martial artist must be affiliated member of IKA.

5 AWARDS

The Gold, Silver and Bronze medal are awarded to the top 3 martial artists. The Bronze medal is awarded to 2 martial artists.

Fifteen minutes before the victory ceremony starts, the medalist shall be escorted to the waiting area for the ceremony. Medalists must wear the uniform of National Federation or Association. Korea and English simultaneous interpretation will be conducted.

6 RULES AND REGULATION

The Kurash competition shall be conducted in accordance with rules and regulations of International Kurash Association (IKA).

In case of any disagreement in the interpretation of the rules and regulations, the English version shall prevail. Any unforeseen cases not covered by the regulations and rules shall be resolved in accordance with the rules and regulations of IKA.

The Kurash competition will proceed according to elimination system in each weight category.

7 INTERNATIONAL AND LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Shuttle bus will be provided to martial artists and team officials according to the information of arrival and departure flight schedule.

7.1 Competition Venue

Shuttle bus will be provided between accommodation and designated competition venue for each event to martial artists and team officials depending on the competition schedule.

7.2 Training Venue

Shuttle bus will be provided between accommodation and designated competition venue for each event to martial artists and team officials depending on the training schedule.

7.3 Observation

Shuttle bus will be provided to martial artists and team officials for game observation as well. The members who wish to observe team game have priority.

7.4 Luggage

Basically, the luggage should carry to the bus by each personnel. A supplement bus to the destination will be dispatched in case out of the space for an overloaded.

8] HOTEL AND MEAL

Martial artists and team officials will be stayed in designated accommodation which is located in Jincheon County, Chungcheongbuk-do Province surrounding area as Athletes Village. The day of Check-in to the Athletes Village would be 1 days prior to the competition check-out the day after competition. For safety security, an after access accreditation procedure will be needed.

-If it exceeds the quota, the team shall pay 60 USD per each martial artist..

- Each NF or Association can enter only two(2) martial artists per each weight category.

- Each NF or Association can enter maximum twenty(20) martial artists-12 male, 8 female-in total.

9] VISA SUPPORT

Exclusion to the entry without visa based on the agreement of visa exemption, visa issuance to the concerned embassy or consulate at least 45 days before entry. Organizing committee will provide visa invitation letter to the participants after receiving invitation application with confirmation of the head of the association by 15 September 2017 for smooth progress.

10] DUTIES OF PARTICIPANTS

- Each team shall prepare their own national anthem and national flag for the ceremony.
- Each martial artist shall bring their own Yakhtak.
